S6 Mock Exam Arrangement due to School Suspension

7th February, 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The S6 mock exam originally held on 5/2/2020 is cancelled due to school suspension by the Education Bureau (EDB). School resumes on 2/3/2020. The details are as follows,

1. Mock paper
 - a. The soft copies of mock papers (in pdf format) will be sent to students through Google Classroom. Students can also come back to school to get the hard copies of mock papers. The collection period is from 10/2/2020 to 14/2/2020. The collection time is from 8:00am to 4:00pm.
 - b. Students should wear mask when they are at school. Upon arrival to school, please check the body temperature at the school reception and use hand sterilizers.**
 - c. Students should arrange their own time to finish the mock papers and hand in on or before 2/3/2020.
 - d. Students may hand in the mock papers in person or by mail to school. Please write on the envelope “S6 Mock” with your name, class and class no. Also, please make sure the mail bears sufficient postage.
 - e. Students should finish the mock papers within the time allowed indicated on the cover page.
 - f. Students should not refer to any notes or textbooks, seek advice from others or ask for help to finish the exam in order to assess their learning progress.
 - g. Students should use the calculator with “HKEA APPROVED” label.
 - h. The marks of mock papers are part of students’ Term Mark. Please encourage your child to finish the mock papers seriously.
2. Term Mark (composed of daily marks and exam marks)
 - a. The S6 mock paper marks will be counted as 30% of the daily marks.
 - b. The exam marks will be replaced by first term uniform test’s marks.
 - c. When students come back to school getting the mock papers, please also clear their drawers and lockers in their classroom.

If EDB announces the resume of school on 2/3/2020, S6 students should attend school until 11/3/2020. Starting from 12/3/2020 onwards, students do not need to attend school but stay home for self-study. When students come back to school during self-study period, **they should dress in school uniform**. Thank you for your attention.
