Selection of Electives for Senior Secondary Studies

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Within the New Senior Secondary (NSS) academic framework, on top of the four core subjects (Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and Liberal Studies), a student can also, from a vast array of key learning areas and applied learning courses, opt for two to three electives of their own choice.

Parents are thus cordially invited to assist your child with the selection of electives for S.4 according to their interest and aptitude, and to complete the reply slip below to be returned to the class teacher by 23rd April, 2021. The school, with the right to make the final decision, would refer to the prioritised choices and take into consideration both the student's academic performance and the admission quota on each subject when assigning a combination of electives to a student. Students who fail to return the reply slip may be subject to the allotment of any electives the school arranges on their behalf. **The Education Bureau has not finalized the decision on optimizing the curriculum for Senior Secondary in the coming year. The following subject combinations may be revised as announced by the Education Bureau. The school will notify you if there is any latest news.**

Upon registration for the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination, a student is only allowed to sit the subjects enrolled in. Only with exceptional justification and recommendation from the subject teacher concerned can a student register for an elective not signed up for with the school, the application for which should be in within the first two weeks after S.4 starts, by 15th September 2021 at the latest. Every application will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

The allotment results will be announced on 26th July, 2021. Accepted only under special circumstances, applications for reconsideration of a student's assigned electives should be submitted to the Academic Committee by 9th August, 2021. No late applications will be entertained.
